Student Retention and Educate WV Committee – report by Johnna Beane, WVU Health Sciences Center – Charleston Division
Beane reported that she attended the College Completion Task Force meeting in January. She reported on the membership of the taskforce as well as gave us some information on the groups work toward initiatives to raise the college completion rate in WV. Discussion ensued about ideas and examples that could benefit Johnna during the meetings and perhaps the need for a future survey.

Legislative Committee – report by Ken Harbaugh, Shepherd University

Harbaugh reported that there were few changes from last year's SB480 to this year's SB330. Discussion ensued about support of the senate and house bills that address personnel legislation changes. Ken Harbaugh, Shepherd University, made a motion that WVACCE express their sincere gratitude, on behalf of classified employees statewide, to the Senate Education Committee and House Education Committee for introducing personnel legislation in the 2011 legislative session that will benefit and improve the lives of higher education employees in WV. Motion seconded by Robert Long, WV Higher Education Policy Commission. Motion unanimously approved.

Discussion ensued about upcoming anti-bully legislations and the need to support this bill because it will help create a healthy and safe workplace.

Web and Communications Committee -

There was no report from the committee; however, there was a discussion among the members about the need for ACCE to be prepared to answer any public opinion venue questions about personnel legislation.
