Getting to the South Charleston campus

Going East on I-64

- Use Exit 54 (MacCorkle Avenue)
- Turn right at the end of the ramp
- Turn right at the first light (Jefferson Road)
- Get into the left lane on Jefferson Road
- Turn left at the light onto Kanawha Turnpike (after railroad crossing)
 - Go straight through the next set of lights
 - After about a mile, turn right on Angus E. Peyton Drive

Going West on I-64

- Use Exit 54 (MacCorkle Avenue)
- Turn left at the end of the ramp (toward Spring Hill)
- Take a left at the first traffic light (Jefferson Road)
 - Get into the left lane on Jefferson Road
- Turn left at the light onto Kanawha Turnpike (after railroad crossing)
 - Go straight through the next set of lights
 - After about a mile, turn right on Angus E. Peyton Drive
